



Puppy Sale Agreement

This contract is between K9 Corral and _____.

The following puppy _____ was born on _____ and is hereby sold to the undersigned for the purchase price of _____; which must be paid in full before the puppy is released to the new owner. A _____ nonrefundable deposit is due in order to secure the puppy for the undersigned. The seller, by accepting the deposit/full payment (For each puppy requested), agrees to hold the puppy for the buyer until the release time. The nonrefundable deposit will be utilized as the shipping or deducted from the purchase price, which ever applies.

The following puppy _____, to the best of the seller's knowledge is in good health and free of communicable diseases at time of sale. The puppy will have at least two sets of distemper/parvo vaccinations, Bordetella vaccine, and be dewormed before release to the new owner. Validation of the guarantee requires examination of your new puppy by the veterinarian of your choice, at the purchaser's expense, within 48 hours after taking/delivering of the puppy. Purchaser must retain the receipt of the check-up; this is mandatory for the guarantee to be valid. If this is not done, the health guarantee becomes invalid and the buyer assumes all responsibility for the health of the puppy. The guarantee against transmissible diseases such as parvo virus is valid for a period of 7 days, starting on the day of delivery, since the normal incubation period for transmissible disease is 5-7 days. The breeder guarantees the puppy until 1 year of age against all life threatening congenital or hereditary defects. If the puppy has a life threatening congenital or hereditary defect, it will be replaced with the first available puppy of the same value from the breeders stock, as soon as possible. The original puppy must be returned (at owners expense), to the breeder before a new puppy can be delivered. The purchaser is responsible for any shipping fees for the replacement puppy. In the event of a death, a licensed veterinarian must perform an autopsy to determine the exact cause of death at the owner's expense. The report from the autopsy must be sent to my attending veterinarian for review. The health guarantee does NOT include hernias/ruptures, hypoglycemia, coccidiosis, giardia (Which can be caused by the stress of going to a new home), ear mites, intestinal worms, fleas/ticks or any other treatable issues. All veterinarian charges, incurred by the purchaser, are the sole responsibility of the purchaser and will under no circumstances be paid by the seller. All puppies are sold strictly as pets, as no guarantee is made to disposition, conformation, size, weight, color, or breeding ability. All guarantees shall become null and void if the puppy is sold, gave away, or transferred to another person.

This contract contains the entire agreement between the parties and no statement, promises, or inducement made by either party that is not contained in the written contract shall be valid or binding. This contract may not be modified or altered except in writing signed by both parties and endorsed herein. By purchasing your puppy you, the buyer, agree that you have read, understand and accept the terms of this contract.
